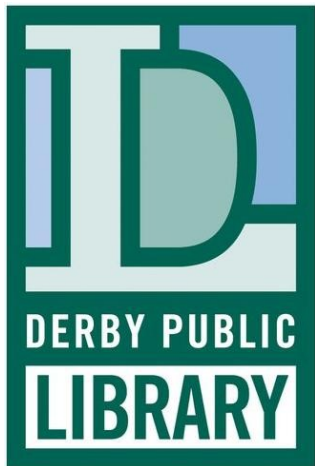

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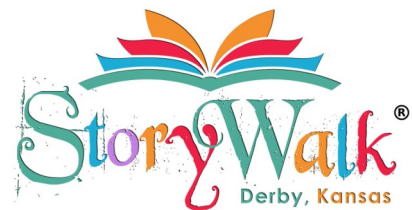
StoryWalk Derby!

There's a new feature at High Park!

The Derby Public Library in conjunction with the Derby Health Collaborative developed StoryWalk® Derby, Kansas to build children's interest in reading while encouraging healthy outdoor activity for children and their families.

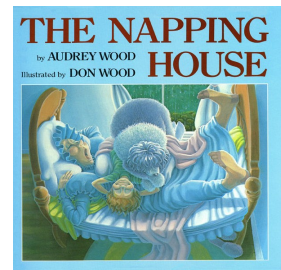
With the assistance of the Derby Parks Department, 20 signs

featuring the pages of a popular children's book have been permanently installed along a path in Derby's High Park. Families are encouraged to visit often as books will be changed five times per year.

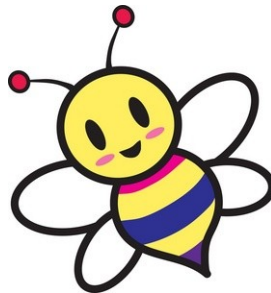

Wonderful Ones is an early literacy introduction to picture books, music, and nursery rhymes for children between 12 and 24 months and their parent/caregiver. 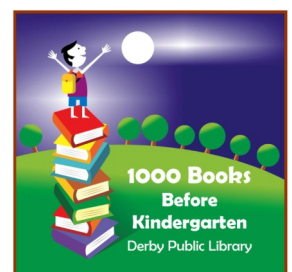
