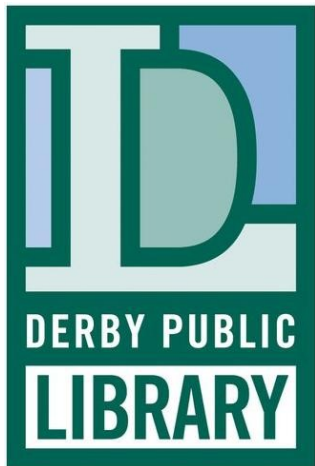

The teens of Derby are writing! This past summer, Miss Alyssa, our teen librarian, hosted a teen writing race. It was wildly successful. Nineteen teens participated, over 100,000 words were written, and 5 teens presented a completed work.

These submissions were turned into zines (short for magazines). The 5 published zines include a steam-punk adventure, a collection of poetry, a western, a historical fiction story, and a science fiction story.
